TRAVELER SAFETY TIPS

A savvy traveler always discusses safety with the family when planning a vacation.

- ◆ Always be aware of your surroundings.
- ◆ Park in a well-lighted area.
- ◆ Always lock your vehicle and never leave valuables in plain view.
- ◆ Stay with your luggage until check-in.
- ◆ Always travel in pairs or groups.
- ◆ Use the sidewalks and pedestrian crossings.
- ◆ Always lock your room door using the deadbolt lock.
- ◆ Place all valuables in the room safe or hotel safety deposit box.
- ◆ Beware of unsolicited business (pizza) flyers left at your hotel door.
- ◆ Keep local and state maps in your vehicle.
- ◆ Ask hotel personnel for directions to your destination.
- ◆ Do not leave your room key or any valuables unattended in the pool area.
- ◆ Review the floor plan on the back of your room door and familiarize yourself with the fire and emergency exits.
- ◆ Give children a hotel business card to help them remember the name, address, and telephone number of the hotel.
- ◆ Secure your sliding glass doors or connecting room door with all security devices provided by the hotel.
- ◆ Report suspicious activity to hotel management or call 9-1-1.
- ◆ Designate a responsible adult to watch your children in the water. Never assume that someone else is watching your children.
- ◆ Do not drink if you are responsible for watching the children and remember that alcohol and swimming do not mix.

ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE E-REPORTING

Go to www.ocso.com and click on "E-Report."

Using this system allows you to submit a report immediately if a crime occurred within the jurisdiction of Orange County. Upon completion you will be given a case number and be able to print a copy of the report to keep for your records.

Complete a report only if there are no known suspects. **If you have a suspect, you CANNOT use this system.** You will need to contact the Communications Center at 407-836-HELP (4357) and have a deputy respond to take a report.

The following reports can be taken through E-Report: lost property, identity theft, theft, lost/stolen license plate, vehicle burglaries, harassing phone calls, vandalism and vandalism to vehicle.
