





More traditional right hand exit ramps

Grand National Drive overpass relieves east/west congestion at the Kirkman Road exits Kirkman Road

**Direct Express Lane** 

Connection eastbound onto I-4 and from westbound to Grand National Drive

Additional ramps constructed but not opened for future expansion

### **Managing Traffic**

SGL Constructors is committed to keeping traffic moving during peak travel times throughout the life of the project.

**Existing traffic lanes open during daytime.** 

Weekday I-4 lane closures limited to mostly nighttime hours occurring as early as 8:30pm and as late as 7am.



Contract allows for additional closure requests by SGL Constructors. FDOT will evaluate and approve those requests on case by case basis.

Work may require ramp closures for extended periods of time.

Construction activities may require weekend work.



#### Work Zone Safety

Motorists hold safety in their hands driving through the I-4 Ultimate work zone. Everyone needs to do their part to help reduce crashes and injuries during construction. Here are some tips to make safety for workers, passengers and you the number one priority.

Be Alert - Pay attention to the road and your surroundings in the work zone.

Don't Tailgate - Unexpected stops frequently occur in work zones. Allow at least two car lengths between you and the vehicle in front of you.

Minimize Distractions - Avoid changing radio stations and using cell phones while driving in the work zone. Dedicate your full attention to the roadway.



Our team's culture places the safety of the traveling public and our workers as a top priority.

Expect the Unexpected - Work zones are changing environments. Keep an eye out for workers and their equipment.

Don't Speed - Follow the posted speed limits in and around the work zone.





#### PROJECT LIMITS:

21 miles from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$2.3 billion

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS:

- » Completely rebuilds free general use lanes along entire corridor
- » Reconstructs 15 major interchanges and constructs more than 140 bridges
- » Adds four dynamic price tolled Express Lanes in the median
- » Increases design speed to 60 mph
